There are people from Jamaica, Poland, Dominican Republic, Peru, Chile, Russia, Columbia, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Mongolia and Turkey. They are mostly college students, working hard at various jobs here in the community. Jeff thought it would be a good idea for our church to host a supper for these workers to welcome them and get to know them better. He suggested we do this sooner than later and said Sunday evening was the best time for most workers since they don't have lots of spare time.

The Food Committee (Foodies) thought this was a great idea, so faster than a speeding bullet, we chose Sunday, July 2nd at 5:30 p.m. for the church to host a "summer foods" potluck supper.
